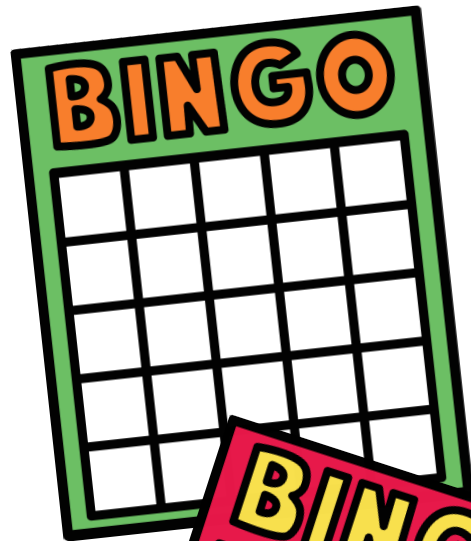
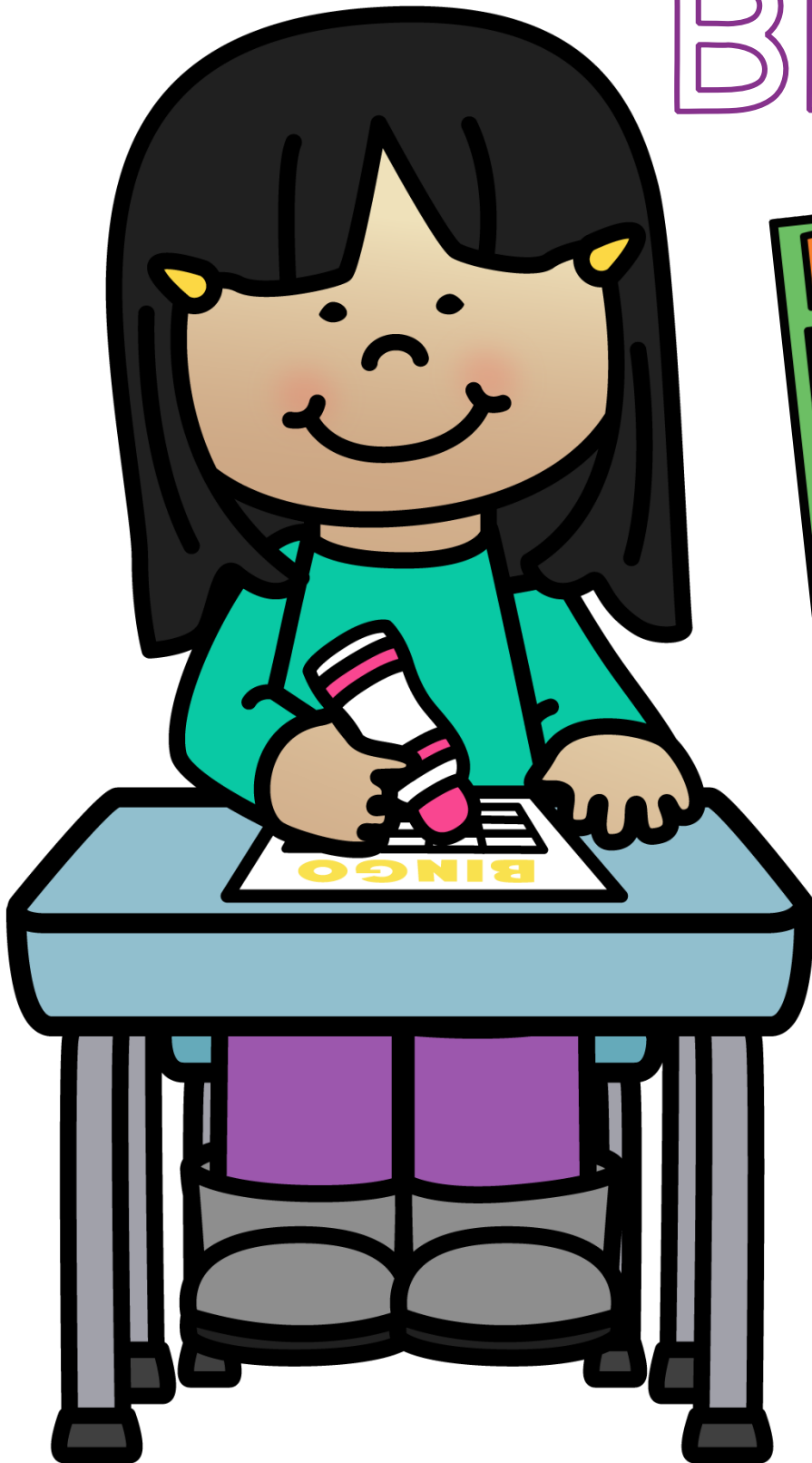


ALPHABET BINGO



Alphabet Bingo Lowercase

Instructions

Print on cardstock.

Cut out alphabet cards. Put cards in a container. Draw one at a time. Call out the card. Student should cover the spot on his or her board, if he or she has that letter of the alphabet. You can use a variety of materials to cover the board: alphabet cookies, buttons, pompoms, or whatever you have.

Advanced version: call out words that begin with the letter on the call out card. For example, instead of calling out "letter A," call out "apple."

Continue calling out letters (or words) until a student has five in a row (BINGO!).

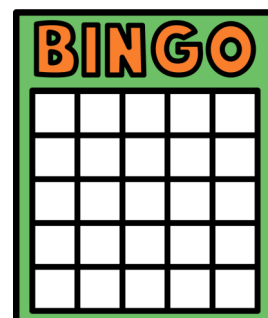
