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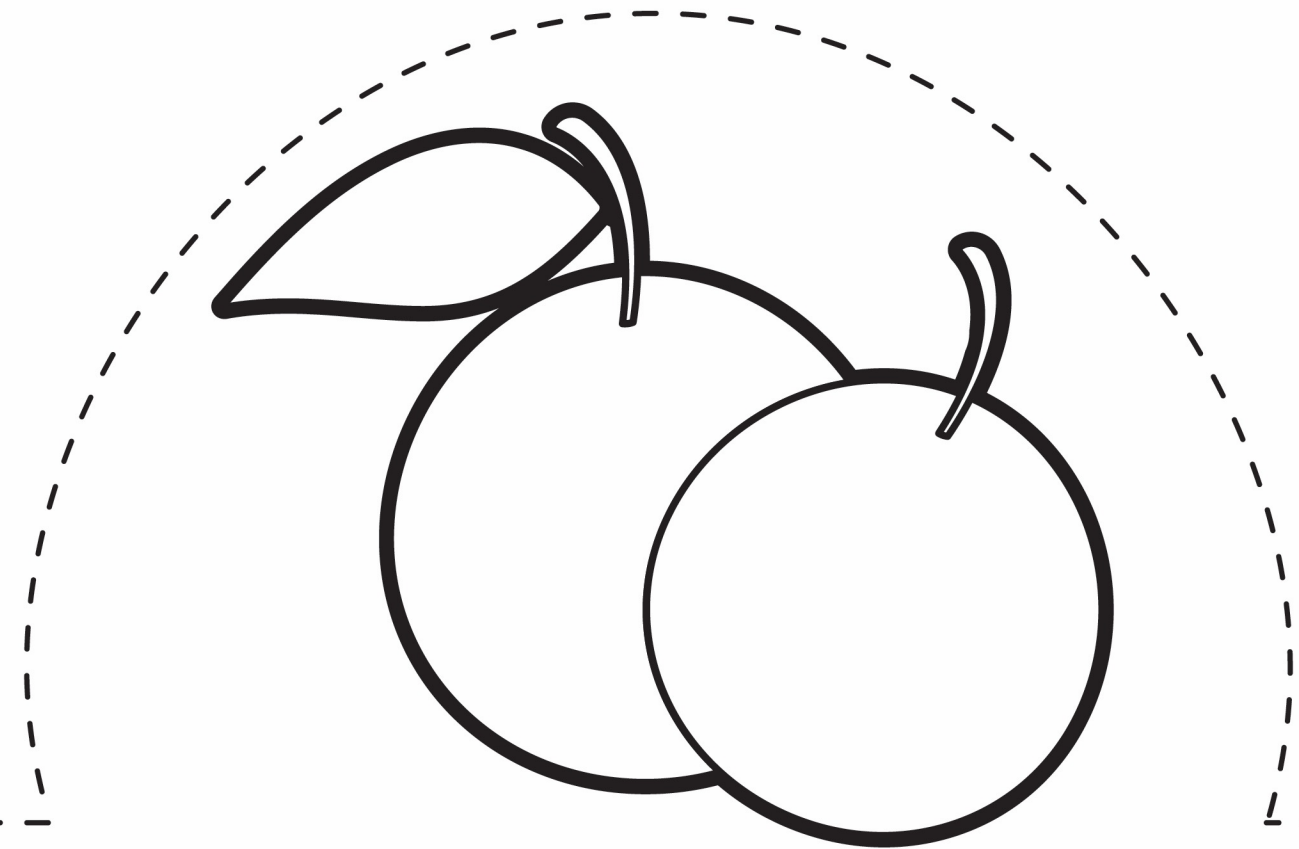

Directions:

1. Print the pages on copy or card stock paper.
2. Color the pictures. (There are extra pictures on page 3 in case you are printing multiple copies.)
3. Cut along the dashed lines.
4. Paste the pictures in the life cycle order on the front of the hat. (seeds, seedling, flower, tree and orange)
5. Cut out the two strips on page 4. Staple them to the front part of the hat.
6. Wrap the hat around the child's head and tape or staple it so it fits them. You may only need one strip if the child's head is small.
